GENERAL INFORMATION:

The TDAA Petit Prix is sponsored and managed by the TDAA Board of Directors both to showcase the talents of our dog and handler teams and to provide a celebration of small dog agility. The Petit Prix will be held on the second weekend of October each year. The TDAA treasury is responsible for all incurred expenses and will deposit any profit and absorb any losses.

The Associate Director will accept applications from all groups interested in having the event in their area. Clubs or other groups may combine resources to co-host the Petit Prix. These groups will need to provide the manpower and support system to carry off the event. There will be no financial burden for the host group. Our intent is to choose the sites for the next 2 years so be sure to indicate below which year(s) you are interested in hosting the Petit Prix.

The Petit Prix will be managed by the PP Planning Committee in cooperation with the host group who will responsible for the local logistics and adding the flavor of the region to our national event.
