### **From Little Rock and north:**

Take I-30 West to exit 126. Turn right at Alexander Rd/AR Hwy 111. Go .4 miles to Stop sign. Turn left onto AR Hwy 5/Stagecoach Road. Stay on Hwy 5 for 1.9 miles to Hilldale Road on the right (Pinecrest Cemetery on the corner). Turn right and stay on Hilldale Road 1.6 miles to the 4-way STOP. (Hilldale will take a sharp left and right turn.) Go straight at the stop sign and you will be on Anderson Road. The farm is .4 mile on the right. Look for the brick entryway.

### **From Benton and south:**

Take I-30 East to exit 123. Turn left onto Reynolds Road (the overpass). Go straight to AR HWY 5/Stagecoach Road. Turn right onto AR Hwy 5/Stagecoach Road. Stay on Hwy 5 for 1.7 miles to Hilldale Road on the left (Pinecrest Cemetery on the corner). Turn left and stay on Hilldale Road 1.6 miles to the 4-way STOP. (Hilldale will take a sharp left and right curve.) Go straight at the stop sign and you will be on Anderson Road. The farm is .4 mile on the right. Look for the brick entryway.

## **Entries:**

Entries close at 6:00 PM April 2, 2010, after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries **without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded after the closing date if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. For any bitches that are pre-entered and come in season, a refund of entries for all but \$10 will be issued, upon receiving a letter (not email) from a vet. Deadline for refund request is April 16, 2010.

Day of event entries will not be accepted for this trial.

## **Notice to Exhibitors:**

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with, and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

**All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**No dogs allowed in the barn. Please remember this is a private working ranch and we are privileged to be allowed to use this facility.**

**Please pick up after your dogs at the trial location as well as the hotels.**

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

**PLEASE remember to attach a copy of your height card to your entry or be prepared to present it at check-in. Dogs for which no jump height card is presented or that do not have one must be measured at the trial.**

### **Eligibility :**

This trial is open to all teacup dogs (which are dogs under 17" at the withers), over the age of 12 months except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

**Your dog must be registered to participate in TDAA Trials.** There is a registration form included in this premium that can be returned with your entry, or you may register your dog at the trial. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at [www.k9tdaa.com](http://www.k9tdaa.com).

## **Standard Class**

**Beginner Agility** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

**Intermediate Agility** – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Superior Agility** – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

## **Games Class**

**Games I** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

**Games II** – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TGI) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

**Games III** – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TGII) or Games III (TGIII) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

\*Final running order will be sent with confirmation.

**Measuring for all dogs without a permanent jump height card will be available from 7:45 to 8:15 am on Sat., and 7:30 to 8:00 am on Sun. There will be a judges' general briefing at 8:15 am on Saturday and at 8:00 am on Sunday to familiarize all participants with TDAA rules. Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will follow general briefing.**

**Judging will start at 9am on Saturday and 8:30am on Sunday.**

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

**Obstacle familiarization:** Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered before the first class Saturday. Dogs not competing Saturday will be allowed familiarization before the first class on Sunday.

**Warm-ups:** A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump and other equipment as available, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

## Games Classes

Judge's Briefing on the day of the trial supersedes any previous briefing.

**COPY CAT:** Copycat is a dog's choice game. That means the handler can direct the dog through the performance of obstacles in the order and direction of his own choosing, or the dog's choosing as the case may be. The dog can perform each obstacle only twice for points. If the dog performs the same type of obstacle back-to-back, called "copycatting" (for example, 2-one point, 2-three point or 2-five pointers), he will lose points.

**QUIDDITCH:** Each team will have 60 seconds to complete three numbered sequences. When time expires the dog should be directed to the table to stop time. Each sequence is worth a different point value and can be successfully completed only once. The sequences can be taken in any order. A bonus is awarded for doing all three sequences and for each distance send through the tire.

**GAMBLERS ANONYMOUS:** This game is a point accumulation game consisting of mini-gambles which, when completed, earn points. Before entering the game with a roll of the dice, one gamble will become a "zero" gamble for the team and one gamble will become a "double" gamble for the team.

**IMPOSSIBLE TUNNEL:** The purpose of the Impossible Tunnel Game is to successfully complete a numbered course in the standard course time. Any off course is faulted and any knocked bar is faulted. Refusals will not be faulted. Time stops when the dog crosses the finish line.

## Obstacles to be Used

The following is a list of obstacles to be used:

- A-Frame, slats (6'8"ramp)
- Tire Jump (16")
- Open (pipe) Tunnel (16")
- Teeter, no slats (8' ramp)
- Closed (collapsed) Tunnel-Chuck Wagon with 6' chute
- Weave Poles (18" centers)
- Single and Winged Jumps
- Dogwalk, slats (8' ramp)
- Table (36"X36")

**All obstacles meet TDAA equipment size requirements.**

## FEO Class

**FEO** – TDAA now offers FEO (For Exhibition Only) runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates. No treats or food allowed in ring. Toys may be allowed, at the judge's discretion. The maximum course time for an FEO run is 1.5 times the Standard Course Time for the class.

Weekend FEO entries may change to regular classes at the end of the day on Saturday for Sunday runs only. In such case, a written request must be submitted to the trial secretary at the end of the day on Saturday.

**Move-Ups:** Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show until Monday, April 12, 2010. Move up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email.

Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the written move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned and before the next walk thru.

#### **Measured Height Divisions**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All dogs that do not have a permanent jump height card must be measured before judging begins. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement, then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- 8" and under at the withers jumps 4"
- 12" and under at the withers jumps 8"
- 15" and under at the withers jumps 12"
- 17" and under at the withers jumps 16"

Dogs competing with either a body-type (long-backed, dwarfish legs/deep chested, or weight-to-height provision) exemption, veteran jump height exemption, or both exemptions, will be scored and placed with the height class they measure into.

#### **Jump Height Exemptions:**

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see rules for complete description of height exemptions at: [www.k9rdaa.com](http://www.k9rdaa.com)). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age).

#### **Fast Track**

The fast track option will not be offered at this trial.
