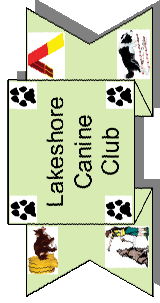

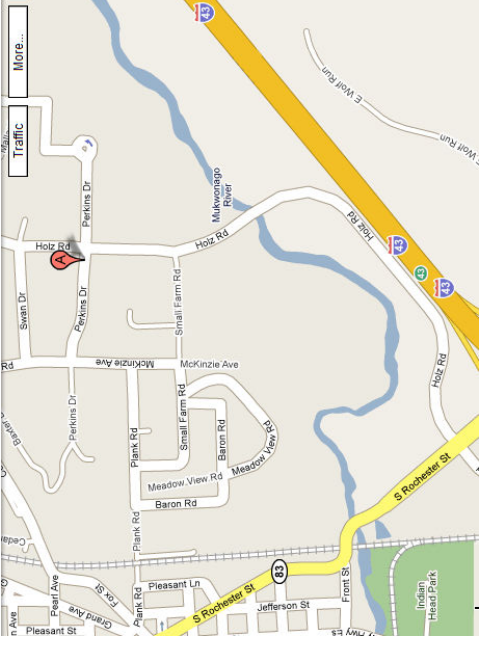

From I-43, take the Mukwonago exit and go North on HWY 83. Turn right on Holz Parkway (the frontage road). Turn left on the second street (Perkins Dr.). Immediately turn right into our parking lot.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with, and are able to perform all obstacles safely. All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish. At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

ELIGIBILITY:

This trial is open to all teacup dogs (which are dogs under 17" at the withers), over the age of 12 months except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered to participate in TDAA Trials.

There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com

CLASS INFORMATION: The order of classes may be changed at the discretion of the Trial Host and the Judge. Please be alert for announcements during the trial. Treats, food and toys are not

permitted in the course area. Handlers are also not allowed to use whistles, squeakers, other instruments or devices.

JUDGING TIMES: 1st dog on the line Saturday 9:00am, Sunday 8:30am.

NEW Class

FEO – TDAA now offers FEO (For Exhibition Only) runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates. No treats or food allowed in ring. FEO teams will receive 1.5 times the Standard Course Time for their run.

STANDARD CLASS:

BEGINNER AGILITY - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations. (However, see rules for fast track titling.) **Beginner**

Standard courses do not include weaves.

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY - Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY - Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) or the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES CLASS

GAMES I - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations. (However, see rules for fast track titling.) **Weaves may be required in one Games I course.**

GAMES II - Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES III - Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES DESCRIPTIONS (all levels): JUDGE'S BRIEFINGS ON DAY OF THE TRIAL SUPERSEDES ANY PREVIOUS BRIEFINGS. Detailed game information available at the trial. For sample courses, briefings and strategies, please review The Clean Run Book of Agility Games, 1st and 2nd Edition by Bud Houston. available from www.cleanrun.com or www.dogagility.org.

Note: Weaves are optional in all Games I classes; **except** Beat the Cuckoo Clock

April Fool's A standard course with a mischievous twist. After walking the course, handler turns his back to course; a runner marks up to 2 obstacles as April Fool's and dog/handler must pass those obstacles. Scored time plus faults. Lowest score wins.

Beat the Cuckoo Clock: 'Spring ahead' by setting the daylight savings clock. Team begins at the center of the clock face (tire) and attempt to successfully 'ring' each hour by completing quarter hour clock sequences (first #1 thru #3' then #4 thru #6; and so on). Handler must direct the dog to the center of clock face prior to beginning each clock

quarter. Weaves are required for G1 if completing sequence 10-11-12 and Cuckoo Bonus. Double Cuckoo Bonus pts are available after the 12th hour is rung). Scored points then time with highest score winning.

Cowboy Dog: Giddy up, let's go barrel race your horse (dog)! Barrel racer (handler) must send his horse from a distance and turn around three barrels (plastic pails) within a series of sequenced tunnels and jumps. Spectator hootn' and hollern' is expected. 5 Team Spirit pts earned if both dog/handler compete in rodeo attire: dog (bandana) and handler (bandana). Scored time plus faults. Lowest score wins.

Miniature Golf: Team has 3 golf courses to choose (Contacts, Jumpers or Weaves). After calling 'Four,' handler (the club), 'hits' (sends) his 'ball' (dog) thru the tunnel that corresponds to the golf course they would rather play. However, if the ball does not travel as planned, handler must play the ball as it lies. SCT is average of all three courses. Scored time plus faults. Lowest score wins.

Blackjack (21): Team plays their deck of cards (obstacles) no more than twice to accumulate exactly 21 points in the fastest time. Accumulating more than 21 disqualifies the team. At least one 'Suit' (tunnel/chute), one 'King' (contact/weave) and one 'Ace' (jump) must be successfully completed. No back-to-back obstacles or 2 obstacles in a row. Scored points, then time. Highest point value <=21 wins. Time is tiebreaker.

Egg in Spoon: Dog/handler run a sequenced course with an 'Egg in Spoon' (tennis ball in a ladle) without cracking (dropping) the 'egg.' If 'egg' is dropped, team incurs -5 scrambled egg fault, handler must place the egg back into the spoon and repeat the obstacle closest to the point it was dropped. Standard faults apply except refusals will not be called. Bonus Points: 10 Master Chef pts earned if team has a 'clean run' (no faults). 5 Team Spirit pts earned if both dog/handler compete in kitchen attire: dog (bandana) and handler (apron). Scored time plus faults. Lowest score wins.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score.

SPECIAL JUDGE'S AWARDS: Judge Kris Blacklock will sponsor an Overall Top Male and Overall Top Female Dog award each day. Top Dog Awards are based on 1st through 3rd qualified placings regardless of dog's age, gender, breed, class level or jump height. 1st place Q earns team **4 pts**; 2nd place Q - **3 pts**; 3rd place Q - **2 pts**. **Standard placing Q's earn double points!** Overall quickest time is tie breaker.

WARM-UPS: A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump and plastic pail for 'Cowboy Dog', shall be provided for all exhibitors.

EQUIPMENT:

Following is a list of obstacles to be used: A-Frame (6'6" planks, slatless, rubber pellet surface), Weave Poles, Table (36"), Chute (16" -8', fabric), Single Jumps (30"), Tire Jump (15"), Tunnel (16"), Dog walk, (8' planks slatless, rubber pellet surface), Teeter (slatless, 8' ramp). All obstacles meet TDAA equipment size requirements.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email. Move ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned.

OBSTACLE FAMILIARIZATION: Saturday 8:30am, Sunday 8:00am. A 15 minute familiarization of contact obstacles will be provided on Saturday and again on Sunday for dogs/handlers not present Saturday.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All dogs that do not have a permanent jump height card must be measured before judging begins. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50%, and meets the height requirement, then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- 8" and under at the withers jumps 4"
- 12" and under at the withers jumps 8"
- 15" and under at the withers jumps 12"
- 17" and under at the withers jumps 16"

Dogs competing with either a body-type (long-backed, dwarfish legs/deep chested, or weight-to-height provision) exemption, veteran jump height exemption, or both exemptions, will be scored and placed with the height class they measure into.

JUMP HEIGHT EXEMPTION:

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see rules for complete description of height exemptions at: www.k9tdaa.com). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age).

ENTRIES:

Entries close at 6:00 PM March 29, 2010, after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries **without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are NOT**

acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but ten dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter (not email) before the closing date. **Day of event entries will be accepted at an additional fee of \$3.00 per run/per day. Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no less than 30 minutes before the judge's first briefing.** TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for and received at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Works:

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a “Fast Track” basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. Likewise a dog may move up from Games I to Game III by earning qualifying scores in two lower levels. The dog’s owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. A dog moving up on the Fast Track will not be eligible for placement within the class that he/she received the qualifying score.
